I Training- and examination course

Admission Requirements	Safe handling of a dinghy at 4-5 Bft.
Age Registration Forms Duration Training Contents	 18 years Duly completed online registration (www.vdws.de) Proof of private liability insurance 50% of the course fee (invoice is issued upon receipt of online registration) 8 days incl. examination <u>Theoretical topics:</u> Introduction to course planning, water sport methods, center and course organization, emergency situations, safety, animation, basics in physics, theory of sailing and manoeuvres, equipment and maintenance. <u>Practical topics:</u> Accurate demonstration of manoeuvres, weight and boat trim, emergency situations, improvement of practical skills and model of a catamaran beginner's course.
Examination	<u>Practical examination at 8-20 knots.</u> : Beating to windward, bearing away windward buoy, downwind tacking, jibing, heading up leeward buoy, landing on the boat, casting off backwards, man-overboard manoeuvre. A video of the practical examination can be found here: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=M0ITwsvesC4</u> <u>Teaching ability</u> : Teaching ability in combination with theoretical subject-specific knowledge. <u>Theory</u> : Written examination, duration: 90 minutes.
Status	Participants who pass at least the didactic examination during the seminar will receive the status of VDWS Level 1 Instructor.

II Internship

Admission	Participants who have obtained the status VDWS Level 1 Instructor during the training	
Requirements	course can start their internship.	
Duration	Minimum 21 days covering 100 working resp. training hours.	
Accomplishment The internship can only be completed at a VDWS recognized center, entitled to host		
	internships (dinghy sailing). The current list of internship centers is available on our website www.vdws.de	
Ending	The trainee must keep a record of the contents and the duration of the internship, the corresponding documents are distributed at the end of the instructor course (as PDF via email). The internship booklet must be sent to the VDWS head office.

Status	The status VDWS Level 1 Instructor. will only be replaced by Level 2 Instructor once all examination parts are passed.
Licensing	After successful completion of the training and examination course and the internship, the VDWS Dinghy Instructor Licence is granted. This qualification entitles to teach and to be an examiner of the contents of the VDWS dinghy basic licence and to issue this licence.
Validity Renewal	3 years By participating in a VDWS seminar for further education (1-day seminar, Level 3 Workshop, Center Management Workshop
